
This survey was conducted by phone prior to April 1 and the results have been used by local business leaders to determine gaps in services and to understand how to advocate and support our business community.






Have you closed due to the pandemic?

COVID-19 impacts were swift and strong. Almost half of respondents had closed their businesses. however, almost half the businesses remained open.




If 'social distancina' becomes the new norm, can your business adapt and remain profitable? Adaptability is key to






Do you own or rent your building?





**How many** employees do you have?


