

PORT ALBERNI, B.C. – The IIHF World Junior Championship is returning to British Columbia for the first time in 13 years, and Port Alberni will host a pre-tournament game as part of the Lordco Road to the World Juniors.

On Dec. 21, Kazakhstan and Switzerland will face-off at Weyerhauser Arena (7 p.m. PT) as part of their preparations for the 2019 IIHF World Junior Championship, which runs Dec. 26 to Jan. 5 in Vancouver and Victoria.

Kazakhstan will also take on the Alberni Valley Bulldogs of the British Columbia Hockey League in a pre-tournament game on Dec. 19 (7 p.m. PT).
