Craft cannabis campus planned for the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District

PORT ALBERNI, BC – The management team from Wild Coast Capital are hosting an info session on June 24 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Best Western Plus Barclay Hotel to inform the community about their plans to build B.C.'s first cannapark.

Wild Coast Capital plans to build a series of purpose-built industrial parks for independent cannabis cultivators seeking license approval from Health Canada. When fully operational the cannaparks will offer small-scale cannabis cultivators a turn-key solution for market entry. The first planned facility will be located on a 40-acre industrial site in the Alberni Valley region. It will be built in three phases over three years and when complete, it will be home to 34 independent cannabis partners with over 200,000 square feet of indoor operations and 40 acres of outdoor cultivation.

The Company also intends to lease a portion of the facility to a wholly owned subsidiary which will apply for cannabis cultivation, nursery, R&D, processing, sales and distribution licenses from Health Canada.
